A renewal application has been submitted by High Plainz Strains of Fort Lupton, Inc. The application was submitted with applicable fees. The applicant has not received a license pending conditions of approval from the initial hearing on April 5, 2022. Those conditions were:

- Applicable issuance of building permits and land use approvals as applicable
- Approved site inspections,
- Approved security inspections,
- Any additional background information (if necessary) on any parties providing financing, and
- Maintaining compliance with all state and local laws, codes and ordinances.

The renewal application doesn't indicate any additional background information. The applicant is currently working with the Planning & Building Department to finalize additional conditions of approval by the Planning & Building Department. The application was not attached to the AM due to confidential information and there being no further information because the business is not operating. Staff is seeking approval of the renewal.

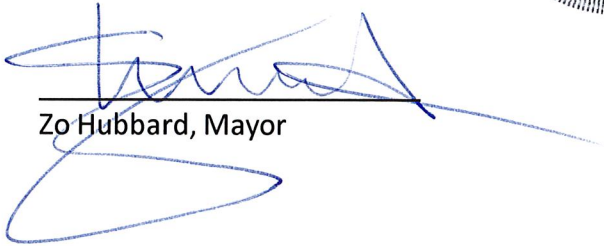
