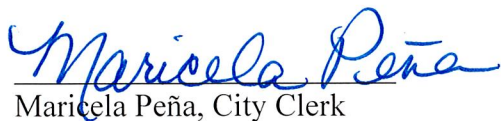

ADJOURNMENT

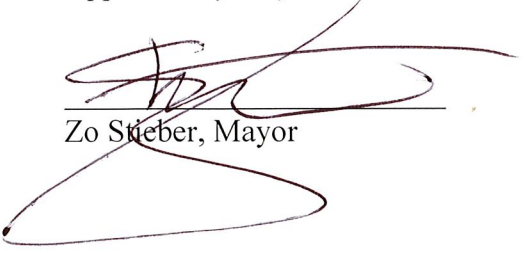
It was the consensus of Council to adjourn the Special Meeting at 2:15 p.m.
