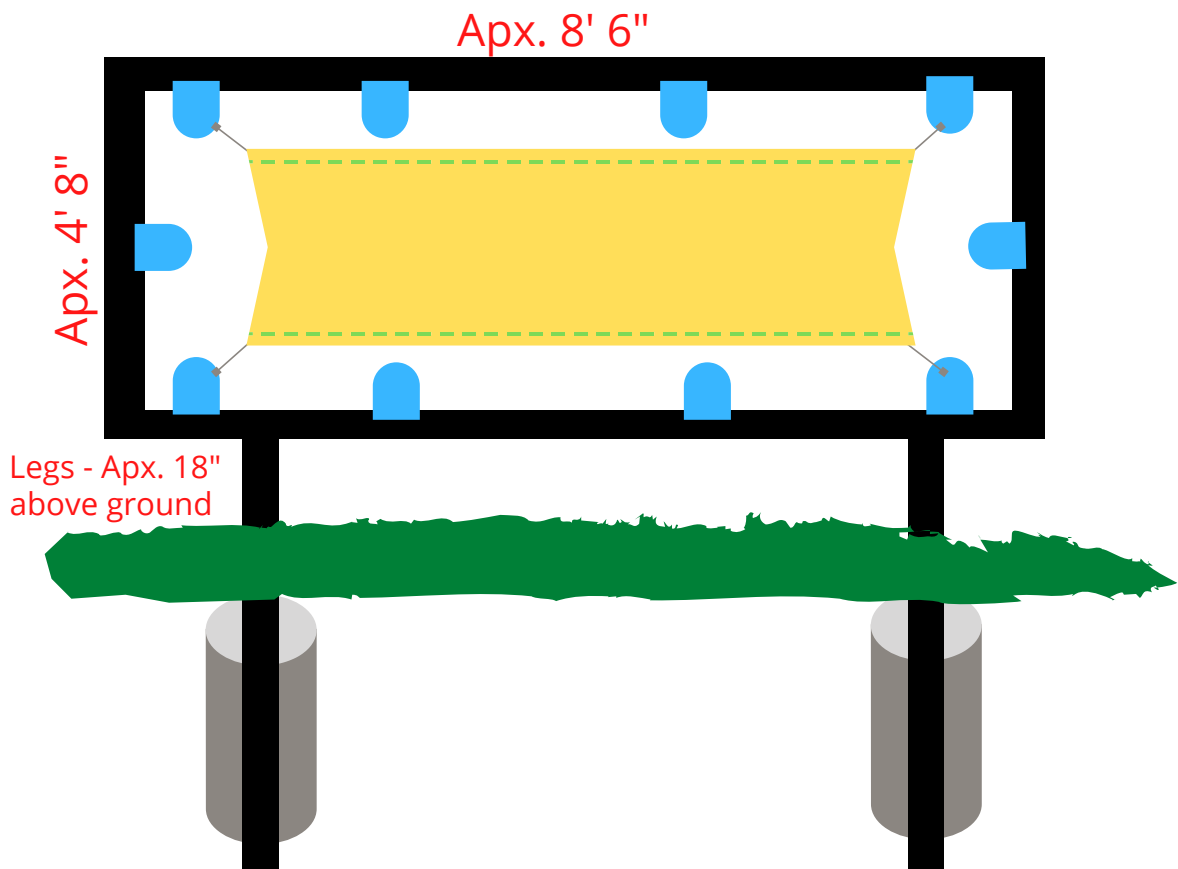

Stable Construction, Attractive Asset

By erecting the permanent frames, at key locations, we offer a strategic, affordable way to promote city sponsored events, school initiatives, PSA's, etc.

Construction:

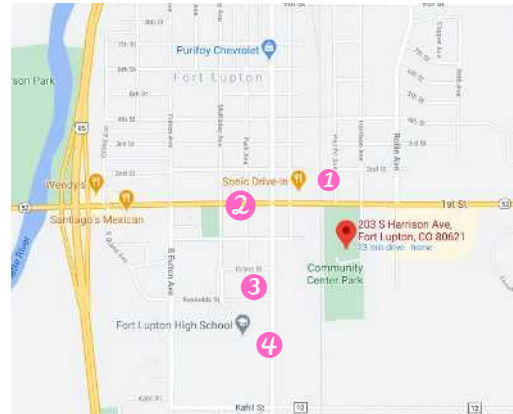
4" square steel tubing with welded 2" D-rings for banner anchoring. Frames will be made to hold banners ranging from 2'3" to 4' x 8' allowing for flexibility, and maximum visibility when needed.



Strategic Placement

1 - 1st St. @ Railroad Park

Location:
Western edge of Railroad Park targeting westbound traffic.



2 - 1st St. & S. McKinley Ave.

Location:
Green belt in the southeast corner of intersection targeting eastbound traffic.



3 - Reynolds St. & S. McKinley Ave.

Location:
On Reynolds St., just east of the bus turn around loop at FLHS.



4 - S. Denver Ave.

Location:
Lawn area adjacent to the "Library" sign targeting northbound and southbound traffic for S. Denver Ave.
